A committee from the Wilson, Chapman, and Longview Subdivisions appeared before the Council requesting that the City assist in securing sidewalks, speed zones, stop signs, caution lights and police patrol for the R. E. Stevenson Elementary School. After much discussion a committee consisting of Councilman Edwards, Councilman Rhea, City Engineer Hughes, Buddy Linton and James Milam were appointed to make a study of these various things that have been requested and the Council asked that this committee bring back the results of this study at the next Council meeting.

Upon a motion of John Edwards seconded by Thomas Rhea and unanimously carried by roll call vote of the members present the Council agreed that the City would make no more purchases from the Del Chemical Company and that the supplies now on hand from the company would be shipped back to the company.

Upon a motion of O. C. Gorham seconded by Thomas Rhea and unanimously carried by roll call vote of the members present the Council gave its approval for the rental of a copy machine and the purchase of an adding machine to be used in the finance department.

Upon a motion of O. C. Gorham seconded by John Edwards and unanimously carried by roll call vote of the members present the Council gave its approval for payment of the deGraffenried Scholarship money to the students who had applied and had their loans approved.

ORDINANCE NO. 70-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL WIRING AND THE INSPECTION THEREOF, ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR AND PROVIDING FOR ELECTRICAL INSPECTIONS TO BE MADE UNDER A PERSONAL SERVICE CONTRACT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KEN-TUCKY.

SECTION I
The office of Electrical Inspector of the City of Russellville is hereby abolished.

SECTION II

The Mayor of the City of Russellville is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a personal service contract with a qualified individual as determined by the Mayor, the City Building Inspector and the Manager of the Russellville Electric Plant Board for the inspection of all new electrical wiring installed within the City of Russellville as set out in the Ordinance of March 4, 1958.

Said contract shall be for one year and shall provide for specific fees for residential and commercial inspections to be paid by the contractor or owner directly to the independent contractor who makes said inspection. The contractor shall maintain his own independent business establishment and pay all expenses incident to said personal service contract including insurance and taxes.

SECTION III

All parts of the electrical inspection ordinance of March 4, 1958 in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
