

ORDINANCE NO. 70-4

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE FIVE DOLLAR (\$5.00) LICENSE FOR MOTOR VEHICLES PLYING THE STREETS OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY.

The Ordinance of the City of Russellville adopted on October 18, 1966 providing for the licensing of motor vehicles plying the streets of Russellville, Kentucky, providing for a license fee of five dollars (\$5.00) and proscribing penalties for the violation thereof, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

This ordinance shall take affect immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
