## <u>O R D I N A N C E</u>

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF A PORTION OF THE INCOME RECEIVED FROM THE INVESTMENTS OF THE deGRAFFENRIED LEGACY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the will of Thomas P. deGraffenried the City of Russellville was bequeathed certain funds to be used by it for the education of the people at large therein, as provided in item "Fourth" of the testator's will, which item is in words and figures as follows:

"I, give, devise and bequeath to the City (or town) of Russellville, County of Logan, State of Kentucky, all of the rest and residue of my Estate to be used by it for the education of the people at large therein."

and,

WHEREAS, it is determined by the City Council of the City of Russellville, Kentucky, that the expenditure of a portion of the income received from the investments thereon as hereinafter set forth is for educational purposes and within the purview of item "Fourth" of the will of said testator; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, as follows:

1. That the sum of Twelve Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Two Dollars (\$12,492.00) of the unpledged income received from the deGraffenried legacy be used to purchase the following uniforms and equipment for the Russellville High School Band:

One hundred band coats; one hundred trousers; one hundred overlays; one hundred shakos including plume and cord; one hundred and twenty-five pairs of gloves; one hundred and twenty-five pairs of spats; one hundred and twenty-five Continental ties; one hundred and twenty-five raincoats; one hundred alternate shakos including ornament and plume; one hundred plastic garment covers; two Drum Major uniforms, including coat, trousers, and belt; one pair of Majorette shorts; seven Majorette capes. 2. That the further sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars (\$1,257.00) of the unpledged income received from the deGraffenried legacy be used to purchase one (1) Groflex Hi-Lite arc 16mm movie projector for exclusive use in the deGraffenried Auditorium.

3. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to do each and everything necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance upon the approval of the provisions of same by the Logan Circuit Court, and this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
