

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE VENDING, SELLING OR TRADING  
OF DOGS OR OTHER SUCH ANIMALS ON THE STREETS OR RIGHTS  
OF WAY OR MUNICIPAL OF OTHER PUBLIC AREAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Russellville  
Kentucky, that pursuant to its power to regulate and restrict actions  
for the purpose of protecting the health, safety and welfare of the  
residents of this City, the vending, selling or trading of dogs or  
other such animals on the streets or rights of way or municipal or  
other public areas is prohibited and any person violating this  
Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and  
fined not less than \$10.00 or more than \$100.00 for each offense.  
This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication  
Councilman Rhea moved that the Ordinance be adopted. Councilman
