

ORDINANCE NO. 79-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 78-1,
ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARY AND
EXPENSES ALLOWED THE CITY
ATTORNEY FOR THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE
THAT THE PARAGRAPH OF ORDINANCE NO. 78-1 which read as follows:

"The salary of the City Attorney for the 1978-79 calendar
years shall be set at \$12,000.00 per year, payable at \$1,000.00
per month for statutory duties plus \$2,000.00 annually for office
expenses."

is amended to read as follows:

"The salary of the City Attorney for the 1979 calendar year
shall be set at \$12,840.00, payable at \$1,070.00 per month for
statutory duties."
