AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER TAP ON CHARGES FOR INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS FOR FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL-VILLE THAT:

Industrial and commercial customers shall be charged a tap on fee of \$200.00 to tap onto the City of Russellville water system for the purpose of fire protection. This fee is imposed to pay the costs of review and inspection for the tap on and up to fifty feet of new line. An additional charge of twenty-five cents per lineal foot for review and inspection for pipe lengths over fifty feet is hereby imposed. Said fee shall be paid to the City Clerk of the City of Russellville, and deposited in the Water and Sewer Revenue Account. Any previous ordinance or regulation of this City in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict; and that this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
