ORDINANCE NO. 81-2

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SELLING OF PRODUCE OR OTHER GOODS OR SERVICES FROM ANY PUBLIC PARKING SPACE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTIONS THERETO AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE THAT it shall be unlawful for any person or other entity to sell produce or goods or services from any public parking space within the City limits of the City of Russellville.

This Ordinance shall not apply to public parking spaces in the privately owned areas to which the public has access where the persons or entity so selling has the permission of the owner of the public parking space in the privately owned area, and the public parking space has not been officially dedicated to the City of Russellville.

This Ordinance shall not apply to properly licensed vendors at specified locations during a local celebration.

Any person or entity, upon conviction of the violation of this Ordinance shall be fined in the amount not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, and each day of said violation shall constitute a separate offense.
