

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS
FROM THE INCOME OF THE deGRAFFENRIED LEGACY

WHEREAS, the Russellville City School Officials have filed written request for an appropriation from the deGraffenried Legacy in the sum of \$35,000.00 to purchase computers and accessories to be used for student instruction in the schools within the City of Russellville Independent School District plus an annual appropriation of \$2,500.00 for supplies and maintenance of said computers, and,

WHEREAS, it is determined by the City Council that purchase and use of said computers is for educational purposes and within the perview of "Item Fourth" of the will of Thomas P. deGraffenried, and,

WHEREAS, it is further determined by the City Council that only one-half of the costs of said computers not to exceed the sum of \$20,000.00 should be paid from the unpledged income realized from investment of the corpus of the legacy and the annual cost of maintenance should be assumed by the board of education rather than from said legacy,

NOW THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City of Russellville, Kentucky, as follows:

1. That the sum of \$20,000.00, or one-half of the cost of said computers, whichever is less, from the unpledged income realized from investment of the assets of the deGraffenried Legacy is hereby appropriated to the Board of Education of Russellville Independent School District to apply on the purchase of said computers.

2. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance upon approval of same by the Logan Circuit Court.
