

Ordinance 85-5 upon its second reading (pre treatment fees).

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 84-13, ENTITLED "ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND ESTABLISHING A FEE AND BILLING PROCEDURE IN CONNECTION WITH THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS, AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY THAT:

Ordinance No. 84-13, entitled "ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND ESTABLISHING A FEE AND BILLING PROCEDURE IN CONNECTION WITH THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS, AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM" be and it is hereby amended as follows:
13-245 Fees for Application for Discharge

A Fee may be charged when a User or prospective User makes application for discharge as required by Articles 13-213 and 13-214 of Ordinance 84-12.

13-249 Industrial Wastewater Discharge Permit Fees

A fee may be charged for the issuance of an Industrial Wastewater Discharge Permit in accordance with Article 13-214 of Ordinance 84-12.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication according to law.
