

ORDINANCE NO. 87- 8

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE OF CHERRY STREET BETWEEN EIGHTH STREET AND HOPKINSVILLE STREET IN THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, AND REPEALING ALL PORTIONS OF ANY PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith TO THE EXTENT OF THAT CONFLICT ONLY, WITH SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE THAT:

WHEREAS, the City desires to maintain proper traffic control within its boundaries in light of present traffic patterns and congestion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE THAT:

SECTION ONE: Parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the East side of Cherry Street between Eighth Street and Hopkinsville Street.

SECTION TWO: Violation of this Ordinance shall result in a fine in the amount of \$25.00.

SECTION THREE: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.

SECTION FOUR: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.

This Ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication according to law.
