

ORDINANCE NO. 88-3

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF FOUR WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF 2nd STREET AND CALDWELL STREET IN THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY:

THAT WHEREAS, the City wishes to properly regulate and control the use of the city streets by vehicles and the City has considered the requests of certain residents to modify the existing regulations at a particular intersection;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Russellville, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The intersection of 2nd Street and Caldwell Street in the City of Russellville, Kentucky, shall be marked by stop signs at each of the four (4) points of intersection and it shall be unlawful to pass through said intersection without coming to a complete stop at the stop signs as required by the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

Section 2. Violation of this ordinance shall result in penalties as specified in the Kentucky Revised Statutes for this type of offense.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. To the extent any provisions of this Ordinance may be in conflict with any previously adopted ordinance, resolution, rule and/or regulation of the City of Russellville,

the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption, approval, attestation and publication as provided by law.
