

ORDINANCE 89- 5
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 81-4
"AN ORDINANCE SETTING SALARY FOR THE MAYOR AND
CITY COUNCIL" BY MODIFYING CERTAIN PROVISIONS
OF THE COMPENSATION TERMS; WITH SEVERABILITY
AND REPEALER CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Russellville, Kentucky, has established compensation terms for the Mayor and City Council members, by Ordinance No. 81-4, and the city representatives desire to modify certain provisions of same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

I. Ordinance 81-4 is hereby amended so that it shall read as follows:

Effective with the term beginning in January, ~~1982~~ 1990, the compensation for the Mayor of the City of Russellville shall be the sum of ~~seventy-two-hundred-dollars-(\$7200)~~ 10,500.00 per annum, which shall be paid in equal consecutive monthly increments thereof, and the compensation for the City Council of the City of Russellville shall be the sum of forty-two hundred dollars (\$4200) per annum, which shall be paid in equal monthly increments thereof; that any previous ordinance or regulation of this City in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict; and that this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication according to law.

II. In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.

III. All portions of any section of any Ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.

IV. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
