

ORDINANCE 91- 6

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF RED AND BLUE LIGHTS  
ON POLICE VEHICLES PER KRS 189.920; WITH SEVERABILITY  
AND REPEALER CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Russellville's police personnel have recommended that the use of red and blue lights are beneficial in law enforcement and other related matters; and the relevant state statute requires the adoption of a local ordinance approving the use of such systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, THAT:

Section 1: The use of combined red and blue flashing, rotating or oscillating lights on police vehicles owned or operated by the City of Russellville is hereby authorized and approved.

Section 2: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provisions.

Section 3: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.


