ORDINANCE NO. 92-/3

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A
PROPERTY CLERK FOR THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY;
WITH A SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WITNESSETH: THAT WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Russellville has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to have a specific employee designated as its property clerk;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE THAT:

- 1) A property clerk shall be employed by the City pursuant to KRS 98.845 and shall have the powers and responsibilities as authorized by KRS 67.592 through 67.594.
- 2) The Mayor shall appoint a member of the City's police department to this position as provided in KRS 98.845.
- 3) The property clerk shall not receive any additional compensation other than the regular pay and benefits associated with his employment as a police officer.
- 4) All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are here repealed to the extent of that conflict only.
- 5) In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.
- 6) This Ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication according to law.
