AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 91-14

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE CONCERNING USE OF THE MUNICIPAL SANITARY SEWAGE COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM, SETTING FORTH POLICY, DEFINITIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE USE OF SAID SYSTEM, CONTROLLING PRIVATE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL, GOVERNING THE BUILDING OF SEWERS AND CONNECTIONS, POLLUTANT DISCHARGE LIMITS, PRETREATMENT PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION, ESTABLISHING THE RIGHT OF THE CITY TO CHARGE FEES FOR ADMINISTERING THE CITY'S REASONABLY NECESSARY FUNCTIONS RELATED TO SEWER USE, AND DELINEATING POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF INSPECTORS AND SETTING FORTH THE METHODS AND PROCEDURES OF ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME AND REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES" BY AMENDING THE LIMITATIONS ESTABLISHED IN ARTICLE V SECTION (B) (12); WITH SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Russellville has previously enacted prior ordinances relating to sewer and wastewater discharges, including Ordinance No. 91-14;

AND WHEREAS, Ordinance 91-14 established certain limitations for any wastewater discharged into the city's sewer system, and said limitations need to be modified to reflect the results of recent analysis and testing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Russellville, Kentucky, as follows:

I. Article V, Section (B) (12) of Ordinance 91-14 be and it is hereby amended so that it shall read as follows:

The following limitations are established for characteristics of any wastewaters to be discharged into the municipal sewer system.

Oil & Grease, hydrocarbons & total	50/100 mg./l
ph	6 to 9.5'
Arsenic, total	±975 0.9 mg/l
Cadmium, total	±045 0.04 mg/l
Chromium, total	.855 mg/l

Copper, total	.675
Cyanide total ( <u>amenable</u> )	<del>12</del> 0.07 mg/l
Lead, total	<del>3</del> 0.15 mg/l
Mercury, total	<del>006</del> 0.0005 mg/l
Nickel, total	.24 mg/l
Zinc, total	.825 mg/l
Silver, total	<del>43</del> 0.41 mg/l
Phenols, total	.9 mg/l
PCB's	.0002 mg/l
TTO	2.13 mg/l
Temperature	40° centigrade

II. The validity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

IV. This Ordinance and its provisions shall be valid for all service areas, regions and sewage works under the jurisdiction of the City of Russellville, Kentucky.

V. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication according to law.
