## ORDINANCE 94- /

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CERTAIN INTERSECTION AS A "STOP STREET"; WITH SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSES AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

THAT WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Russellville has determined that the establishment of a certain intersection as a "Stop Street" is necessary and in the best interest of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, THAT:

Section I: The following intersection is hereby established as a "Stop Street":

- a) The intersection of East 3rd Street and Spring Street for vehicles traveling on 3rd Street from either direction.
- Section 2) Traffic traveling along Spring Street shall not be required to stop at this intersection.
- Section 3: The employees of the City are hereby directed to post stop signs at this intersection in accordance with this ordinance.
- Section 4: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provisions.

Section 5: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only. In particular, Ordinance 93-14 is hereby partially repealed regarding any reference to

3rd Street and Breathitt Street, and this Ordinance is substituted for same.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
