

ORDINANCE NO. 95- 11

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING A PORTION OF HERNDON STREET (aka Herndon Lane);
WITH SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSES ;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

THAT WHEREAS, the City of Russellville has determined that a portion of Herndon Street (aka Herndon Lane) should be closed, and the only abutting landowners have consented to this closing;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE THAT:

Section 1: The portion of Herndon Street (aka Herndon Lane) after its initial length of 304 feet from Kentucky Highway 178 is hereby closed as a public road: This shall not affect the first 304 feet of this street from Kentucky Highway 178 to the eastern boundary of the David Dilliha property which shall remain as a public street.

Section 2: The only property owners that abut the portion of this street being closed are Mr. and Mrs. Joe Hardy and Mr. and Mrs. David Dilliha. All of these individuals have received written notice of this proposed closing and they have all given their notarized consent to the closing.

Section 3: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.

Section 4: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
