ORDINANCE NO. 95- 12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 95-3, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE CONCERNING USE OF THE MUNICIPAL SANITARY SEWAGE COLLECTION AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS, SETTING FORTH THE POLICY, DEFINITIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE USE OF SAID SYSTEM, CONTROLLING PRIVATE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL, GOVERNING THE BUILDING OF SEWERS AND CONNECTIONS, POLLUTANT DISCHARGE LIMITS, PRETREATMENT PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION, ESTABLISHING THE RIGHT OF THE CITY TO CHARGE FEES FOR ADMINISTERING THE CITY'S REASONABLY NECESSARY FUNCTIONS RELATED TO SEWER USE, AND DELINEATING POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF INSPECTORS AND SETTING FORTH THE METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME AND REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES"; WITH CERTAIN TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS AND REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Russellville, Kentucky, has previously enacted Ordinance 95-3, "An Ordinance of the City of Russellville Concerning Use of the Municipal Sanitary Sewage Collection and Wastewater Treatment Works, Setting Forth the Policy, Definitions, Rules and Regulations Regarding the Use of Said System, Controlling Private Wastewater Disposal, Governing the Building of Sewers and Connections, Pollutant Discharge Limits, Pretreatment Program Administration, Establishing the Right of the City to Charge Fees for Administering the City's Reasonably Necessary Functions Related to Sewer Use, and Delineating Powers and Authority of Inspectors and Setting Forth the Methods and Procedures for Enforcement of the Ordinance and Penalties For Violation of Same and Repealing Prior Ordinance and Penalties for Violation of Same and Repealing Prior Ordinances", and

WHEREAS, the City has determined the need to amend said ordinance to make certain technical corrections,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE that said ordinace is hereby amended as follows:

- A) The numbering on the Table of Contents is changed to read as shown on Exhibit "A".
 - B) The word valve is changed to <u>value</u> in definitions #53 and #55.
 - C) The following clause is added to Article II, D, 5:

Any pollutants solids or viscous substances in quantities or of such size capable of causing obstruction to the flow in sewer, or other interference with the proper

operation of the wastewater facilities (ie. wood, glass, ashes, sand, ciders, unshredded garbage, paper products such as cups, dishes, napkins and milk containers, etc.

- D) All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.
- E) This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law. FIRST READING CONDUCTED on July 18, 1995.
