ORDINANCE NO. 95-__20__

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ON A PORTION OF EAST SECOND STREET; WITH REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, HAS DETERMINED
THAT CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING ARE NEEDED IN THE BEST INTEREST
OF THE SAFETY OF ITS CITIZENS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, THAT:

- 1. There shall not be any vehicular parking allowed on East Second Street from Main Street to Caldwell Street. Appropriate signs shall be placed along this street to mark this restriction.
- 2. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be fined not more than 25.00

 Dollars for each offense.
- 3. In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.
- 4. All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.
- 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
