

ORDINANCE NO. 96- 5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.95-3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE CONCERNING USE OF THE MUNICIPAL SANITARY SEWAGE COLLECTION AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS, SETTING FORTH THE POLICY, DEFINITIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE USE OF SAID SYSTEM, CONTROLLING PRIVATE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL, GOVERNING THE BUILDING OF SEWERS AND CONNECTIONS, POLLUTANT DISCHARGE LIMITS, PRETREATMENT PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION, ESTABLISHING THE RIGHT OF THE CITY TO CHARGE FEES FOR ADMINISTERING THE CITY'S REASONABLY NECESSARY FUNCTIONS RELATED TO SEWER USE, AND DELINEATING POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF INSPECTORS AND SETTING FORTH THE METHODS AND PROCEDURES OF ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME AND REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCE AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME AND REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES"; WITH REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Russellville, Kentucky, has previously enacted ORDINANCE NO.94-7" AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE CONCERNING USE OF THE MUNICIPAL SANITARY SEWAGE COLLECTION AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS, SETTING FORTH THE POLICY, DEFINITIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE USE OF SAID SYSTEM, CONTROLLING PRIVATE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL, GOVERNING THE BUILDING OF SEWERS AND CONNECTIONS, POLLUTANT DISCHARGE LIMITS, PRETREATMENT PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION, ESTABLISHING THE RIGHT OF THE CITY TO CHARGE FEES FOR ADMINISTERING THE CITY'S REASONABLY NECESSARY FUNCTIONS RELATED TO SEWER USE, AND DELINEATING POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF INSPECTORS AND SETTING FORTH THE METHODS AND PROCEDURES OF ENFORCEMENT OF THE ORDINANCE AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME AND REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES; WITH REPEALER

AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE and said ordinance included the designation of the portions of the user charge rates of the wastewater treatment works that were allocated to OM & R and to debt service;

AND WHEREAS, the City has determined that the allocation was incorrect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE,

THAT:

1. The last line of the schedule set forth in Article IV, Section 1 of said Ordinance is hereby amended so that it shall read as follows:

All over 1500 gal	1.95 <u>1.71</u>	.48 <u>.72</u>	2.43/1000 gal
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2. In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.

3. All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.

4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
