

ORDINANCE NO. 98- 1
**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, RECOGNIZING
RODNEY HARKELROAD TO SERVE AS DIRECTOR OF DISASTER AND
EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR LOGAN COUNTY AND PROVIDING FOR THE
AVAILABILITY OF SAID DIRECTOR TO PERFORM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS
OF THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR.**

WHEREAS, the City of Russellville recognizes that the Logan County fiscal Court has established a local program for disaster and emergency preparedness, response and recovery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE:

Section 1: That Rodney Harkelroad is hereby designated to serve as Director of Disaster and Emergency Services by the Logan county Fiscal Court and shall routinely be available to respond to emergencies, attend training, and to attend meetings convened by the disaster and emergency services area coordinator.

Section 2: That Rodney Harkelroad, when acting in the capacity of director of Disaster and Emergency Services, shall relinquish authorities and responsibilities associated with any other governmental employment with the city of Russellville and Rodney Harkelroad shall assume those authorities and responsibilities until such time as the director shall cease acting in the capacity of Director.

Section 3: That in no case shall the City of Russellville seek reimbursement for the director's salary for any time spent in another capacity.

Section 4: This Ordinance may be published in summary form in accordance with law.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall have full force and effect after two readings, adoption and publication as required by law.

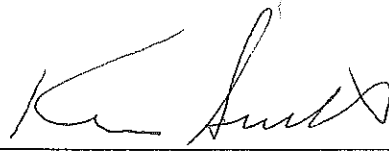
