

ORDINANCE NO. 99-17

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE PRICE OF GRAVE SPACES INCLUDING PERPETUAL CARE, OF OPENING AND CLOSING GRAVES ON WEEKDAYS, HOLIDAYS, AND SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS IN MAPLE GROVE CEMETERY, RUSSELLVILLE MEMORIAL GARDENS, AND GREENWOOD CEMETERY, WITH A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND REPEALER CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEAROF AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 82-16, ORDINANCE NO. 88-4, AND ORDINANCE 83-5

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, THAT:

(1) The cost of grave spaces including perpetual care at Maple Grove Cemetery, Russellville Memorial Gardens, and Greenwood Cemetery shall be as follows:

1 Grave Space	\$200.00

(2) The price of opening and closing a grave at Maple Grove Cemetery, Russellville Memorial Gardens, and Greenwood Cemetery shall be as follows:

Weekdays	\$200.00
Holidays, Saturdays and Sundays	\$250.00

(3) The price of opening and closing a grave in Maple Grove Cemetery, Russellville Memorial Gardens, and Greenwood Cemetery for a cremation or a baby grave shall be as follows:

Weekdays	\$50.00
Holidays, Saturdays and Sundays	\$75.00

(4) If any clause, provision or section of this ordinance shall be ruled void or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder hereof if intended to be enacted and shall be in force and effect notwithstanding.

(5) That all ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

(6) This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
