

ORDINANCE 2000-01

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING OWEN STREET BETWEEN THIRD
AND FOURTH STREETS A ONE WAY WITH TRAFFIC RUNNING
SOUTH AND ALSO AUTHORIZING DIAGONAL PARKING
AND DECLARING WINTER STREET BETWEEN THIRD AND FOURTH
STREETS A ONE WAY WITH TRAFFIC RUNNING NORTH AND
AUTHORIZING PARALLEL PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY:

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the traffic flow for the City of Russellville, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided that it is in the best interest for all citizens of the City of Russellville to declare the portion of Owen Street between Third and Fourth Streets to be one way with traffic flowing South and authorizing diagonal parking on said street and to make Winter Street between Third and Fourth Streets one way with traffic running North with parallel parking on said street, and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council for the City of Russellville does hereby ordain that the portion of Owen Street between Third and Fourth Streets shall be one way with traffic flowing south with diagonal parking, and that the portion of Winter Street between Third and Fourth Streets shall be one way with traffic flowing North with parallel parking on said street.

If any part of this ordinance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the ordinance. All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its proper passage and publication as required by law.
