ORDINANCE NO. 2000-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, CLOSING A PORTION OF AN UNUSED AND UNIMPROVED ALLEY LOCATED OFF OF RUSSELL STREET, WITH THE SEVERABILITY AND REPEALER CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Russellville has made a determination that it is appropriate to close a portion of an unimproved alley which is not in use which is off Russell Street, and WHEREAS, said alley has, to the best determination of the City Council of the City of Russellville,

never been in use and is overbuilt by an existing tobacco warehouse;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, THAT:

SECTION I. That the portion of the unimproved and unused alley off of Russell Street designated on the attached survey plat, crossing what is Tract I on said plat, is closed as a public way, to the extent that it crosses Tract I.

SECTION II. In the event any provision of this ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect any validity of any other provision.

SECTION III. All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule of regulation and conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict only.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication according to law. FIRST READING conducted this the 6th day of June, 2000.
