

ORDINANCE 2002-12

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING AND LEVYING THE 2002 ANNUAL PROPERTY TAX ON REAL PROPERTY AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY WITH REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the property assessment for property with the City of Russellville, Kentucky, has been certified as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE THAT:

SECTION ONE: There is levied for the year 2002 an ad valorem tax of twenty-two and one tenths (\$0.221) per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) assessed valuation of all taxable real property within the jurisdiction, and an ad valorem tax of thirty-three and six tenths (\$0.336) per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) assessed valuation on all taxable tangible personal property within the jurisdiction.

a.) There are hereby levied the following tax rates on the assessed value of all public service corporations as certified by the Kentucky Department of Revenue, as being located and/or doing business within the corporate limits of the City of Russellville, Kentucky, as of January 1, 2002.

| Franchise – Real Estate | \$0.221 |
| Franchise – Personal Property | \$0.336 |

SECTION TWO: Penalty and Interest

a.) Any taxes remaining unpaid on the first day of the month following that in which they become due and payable shall be deemed delinquent and shall bear interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum from the due date until paid; a penalty of six percent (6%) per annum on the taxes so delinquent shall also be paid.

SECTION THREE: In the event any provision of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other provision.


SECTION FOUR: All portions of any section of any ordinance or rule or regulation in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict only.
