CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 2010-04

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME, DATE AND PLACE OF THE REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, REPEALER CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, KRS 83A.130(11) provides City Council shall hold regular meetings at least once each month at such times and places as are fixed by Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Russellville, Kentucky, desires to clarify its records and to publish an Ordinance fixing the time, date and place of its regular meetings;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS

FOLLOWS:

SECTION I - City Council shall hold regular meetings twice each month, the first on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of each month at 5:00 p.m., and the second on the third Tuesday after the first Monday of each month at 5:00 p.m., based on the official time then prevailing throughout Logan County, Kentucky, provided; however, that whenever the first or third Tuesday after the first Monday of a month falls on a legal holiday then the regular meeting for that month shall be held on the ensuing Tuesday which is a secular day at the regular time of that meeting.

SECTION II - The regular meeting place at which said City Council shall hold its meetings shall be at the City Hall in said city.

SECTION III - Special meetings of said City Council may be called at any time by the Mayor or upon a written request of a majority of the members of the City Council, by written notice delivered personally or by mail at least 24 hours prior to the time specified for the proposed meeting, to each member, to the Mayor, to each local newspaper of general circulation, to each news service, and to each local radio or television station which has on file with the City of Russellville a written request to be notified of special meetings of said City Council, in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.

SECTION IV - **SEVERABILITY CLAUSE** - If any section, subsection, or clause of this ordinance shall be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, and clauses shall not be affected.

SECTION V - **REPEALER CLAUSE** - All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI - **EFFECTIVE DATE** - This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication as required by law.
