

**CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2010-16**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 89-5, " AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 81-4 'AN ORDINANCE SETTING SALARY FOR THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL' " BY INCREASING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, REPEALER CLAUSE AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Russellville, Kentucky, has established compensation terms for the Mayor and City Council members by Ordinance No. 89-5, and the city representatives desire to increase the compensation received by the Mayor and to amend said Ordinance accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

A. AMENDMENT. Section I of Ordinance 89-5 is amended as follows:

Effective with the term beginning in January, ~~1990~~ 2015, the compensation for the Mayor of the City of Russellville shall be the sum of ~~\$10,500.00~~ forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) per annum, which shall be paid in equal consecutive monthly increments thereof, and the compensation for the City Council of the City of Russellville shall be the sum of forty-two hundred dollars (\$4200.00) per annum, which shall be paid in equal monthly increments thereof; that any previous ordinance or regulation of this City in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of that conflict; and that this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication according to law.

B. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any particular state of case is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or parts of this Ordinance, it being the legislative intent of this body to ordain and in act each other.

C. REPEAL OF EXISTING ORDINANCES. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith now in effect, to the extent of said conflict, are hereby repealed.

D. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
