AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 2000-02 & 2001-05 BY ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT OF ISSUING A NOTICE OF VIOLATION TO REPEAT OFFENDERS WITHIN THREE YEARS AND INCREASING THE FINES FOR CERTAIN OFFENSES RELATED TO PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RUSSELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, THAT:

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Board has recommended to the City Council and the

Mayor that the amount of the fine for certain offenses be increased; AND

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Board has recommended to the City Council and the

Mayor that individuals receiving multiple NOV's for the same violation be penalized.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained as follows:

I. SUBSTANTIVEAMENDMENTS.

(A) Ordinance 2000-02 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 9. Enforcement Proceedings.

i) In the event the Code Enforcement Officer determines that a Notice of Violation
has been issued for the same property, to the same property owner, regarding the same violation,

within the past three (3) years, then the Code Enforcement Officer shall not issue another Notice

of Violation, but instead shall issue a citation, and if necessary, take steps to abate said violation.
